DELIVERY PACKAGE PRICES

Please note that the below package prices are based on the cost of a consultant-led delivery only. Any charges incurred outside of the below package costs will be invoiced separately.

The price you will be required to pay is the price pertaining on the day of admission, not the price on the day of your booking.

* these prices are for the hospital fees only. They do not include any fees that will be due directly to your consultant obstetrician, consultant paediatrician and/or consultant anaesthetist.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Induction of labour

If you require an induction of labour, an additional charge of £550 will be applied. You will be accommodated on the induction ward within Kingston Hospital's maternity unit where you will be monitored by a team of midwives. Your consultant obstetrician will also assist in monitoring your progress throughout your induction.

Instrumental deliveries

Should it be clinically necessary, your consultant obstetrician will carry out an instrumental delivery either through the use of forceps or a ventouse. For such instrumental deliveries, an additional charge of £525 will be applied.

Multiple deliveries

A £550 charge will be applied for each multiple delivery.

Epidural

A charge of £270 will be applied if you decide to have an epidural during your labour. This charge covers the cost of the drugs and the equipment used to administer the epidural only. Please therefore note your consultant anaesthetist will charge you a separate fee for their services.

Accommodation

Any accommodation utilised in addition to what is included in your chosen package price will be charged as follows:

Antenatal admission within Kingston Hospital's maternity unit	£600 per night
Extra postnatal stay in KHFT Maternity including one-to-one midwife care	£995 per night
Extra postnatal stay, excluding one-to-one midwife care	£600 per night
Antenatal Day Assessment Unit attendance (up to 3 hours including monitoring)	£280
Antenatal Day Assessment Unit attendance (over 3 hours including monitoring)	£525
Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) admission	£2,924 per night
Special Care Baby Unit (SCBU) admission	£1,462 per night

Check out of all rooms is at 12pm on the day of discharge. Late discharges will be charged at the same rate as day attendances to Kingston Private Health.

Antenatal classes

Additional care

Any unplanned additional interventions ordered by a member of the clinical team responsible for your or your baby's wellbeing will be charged at additional rates. This includes any transfer to another specialty of care, including admission to the intensive care unit or high dependency unit.

Specialist care for your baby

If your baby requires transfer to a specialist unit, including the neonatal intensive care unit (NICU), or requires intervention under the instruction of the neonatal team either within the maternity unit or on Kingston Private Health, additional charges will be applicable.

If you are entitled to NHS care, you may elect to use the NHS service within Kingston Hospital NHS Foundation Trust. As part of the booking process, it may therefore be necessary for us to request additional information from you to ascertain whether you are entitled to NHS care for this purpose.

The charges set out in this brochure are indicative only and we strive to keep you informed of any additional charges that may be incurred throughout your stay with us. However, this may not always be possible. Notwithstanding this, you will remain responsible for settling the final balance on your account.

For the avoidance of doubt, the following items are not included within any of our consultant-led delivery package prices:

- Professional fees for obstetric services
- Professional fees for anaesthetic services
- Consultant fees relating to neonates (i.e. baby check) or any other specialty
- Blood transfusions, diagnostic tests and injections not specified in the package
- Non-routine take-home medication
- Any additional accommodation utilised outside of agreed package
- Additional guest meals (excluding partner meals)

PAYING FOR YOUR CARE

To confirm your booking with Kingston Private Health, we will require you to complete the Private Patient Undertaking to Pay Form and we will request a deposit from you in line with the cost of your expected delivery type. Please see the table below:

The deposit must be paid in advance of your midwife pre-admission appointment and no later than 14 days prior to your theatre booking date for an elective section.

Loyalty births – 10% discount

For those expectant mothers who we have the pleasure of welcoming back to Kingston Private Health for another delivery, we are delighted to be able to offer a 10% discount on the cost of any of our delivery packages.

Unfortunately, this discount is not applicable if you are covered by a third party. In addition, the discount is only applicable on the package price and does not apply to any additional charges that may be incurred during your stay with us.



HEALTH INSURANCE

Most insurance companies do not cover maternity care. However, if your medical insurer is willing to cover your maternity care, then it remains your responsibility to obtain appropriate authorisation prior to your admission. We also advise that you discuss the extent of your cover with your insurer as early in the process as possible so that you are clear on what it is you are covered for. This also includes liaising with your insurer on the extent of cover relating to the care of your new baby.

As part of the booking process, you will be required to provide Kingston Private Health with the following information:

- your policy/membership number
- authorisation number

In addition, you must provide confirmation that your insurer will be responsible for meeting all or some of the costs associated with your delivery by way of supplying Kingston Private Health with a Guarantee of Payment letter. The Guarantee of Payment letter must document the following:

- limits of cover
- authorised length of stay
- any excess on your policy (this will need to be paid by you prior to your discharge)

If for any reason we are not provided with any of this information in advance of your admission, you will be required to settle all costs associated with your stay directly with Kingston Private Health and claim the money back from your insurance company.

Please also note that your insurer may not cover all associated costs, including any professional fees due. If this is the case, it will remain your responsibility to cover any insurance shortfall.

HOW TO FIND AND CONTACT US

Kingston Private Health is situated within Kingston Hospital and located on the 7th floor of EsherWing. Its central location within the main hospital means that it is only a short distance from the maternity unit.

Parking

The private car park is located to the rear of Esher Wing and can be accessed from Kingston Hill. Our car park is free for our patients providing your registration details have been recorded on your arrival at reception.

Arriving by car

Kingston Hospital is easily accessed by car from London and the South via the A3 exiting along Kingston Hill Road from the Robin Hood roundabout.

If using sat nav, please use postcode KT2 7QF for Kingston Private Health's car park, accessible via Kingston Hill.

Arriving by train

If you choose to travel by train, Norbiton station is only a few minutes' walk from the main hospital entrance.

Arriving by bus

Buses stopping at the hospital include the K1, K2 and number 57.
